

Munster Ladies Football Development Update

This month has already been very busy for development in Munster. Munster Council has already created an operational plan for the year to assist them in achieving the many targets and programmes in areas of Schools, Finance, PR, Referees, Leadership and Development. This combined with a calendar of events for 2012 should go a long way to assisting all officers with their roles.

The new President, Brian Enright along with the Development Officers and Referees Director will visit each county in the coming weeks to meet with development subcommittee members and executive members.

In the coming weeks 7 third level colleges will introduce a programme called Ladies Gaga for students who want to participate in Ladies Gaelic Football on a purely non-competitive, recreational level. The 6 week programme in each college will culminate in a Munster Blitz on Wednesday 28th March in Cork Institute of Technology.

The schools coaching programme established in September will be coming to a close soon and a full report will be produced to include recommendations for the next phase of the programme. Transition year programmes will be delivered and first year blitzes will take place throughout the province making it yet another very busy time for ladies football in the schools.

Again Gaelic4Girls will take place in many sites across the province and anybody with recommendations for possible sites is asked to contact the Development Officer.

All six counties are already very busy planning courses for coaches, officers, and referees, many of which can be viewed on the Munster Calendar on the Munster Ladies Football website. All members in counties and clubs are encouraged to avail of these programmes as a means of up skilling and gaining new information for the year ahead.
