

Limerick Ladies football to host club officer programme for Limerick and Clare:

What is the Club officer Programme? An informational seminar, specific to Club Executive Committees of the Ladies Gaelic Football Association.

What information will be provided at the seminar? Generic presentations and officer specific presentations.

What Generic Presentations? Injury Fund Scheme, Sourcing Funding Within Counties and Club Development Planning. – 30 min each.

What officer specific presentations? A 1hr presentation will be delivered in breakout rooms for club Chairpersons, Secretaries, PROs, Registrars/Treasurers and Children's Officers.

How long will it take: This programme will take 2.5-3 hours in total to complete.

The success of the programme relies on the clubs, attending and participating. All clubs are asked to ensure that the relevant officers, Chair, Secretary, Treasurer/Registrar, PRO and Children's Officers, attend the programme. If your club is an integrated club with the GAA, and your Officers are also GAA Officers, we ask that 5 members attend who look after the Ladies Gaelic Football section of the club. **The Ladies Gaelic Football section within all Clubs should be represented at the programme. Remember this programme is part of the Merit Based Funding Programme and so attendance is very important.**
